Living for Jesus

In the weeks leading up to Easter, I generally start reading Scripture related to Jesus' death and resurrection. This is a time that causes me to reflect on the magnitude of God's love as demonstrated in the sacrifice of His Son. During the Easter season, it is important to reflect on all that was accomplished by Jesus on our behalf. It is also very important to consider what implications those accomplishments should have on our lives today.

In 2 Corinthians we read, "He died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised." One thing that flows out of Jesus' death and our salvation is that we have a new reason to live. As Paul tells us in 2 Corinthians we are now to live, not for ourselves but for Him, who died and was raised for us.

What does it mean to 'live for Christ'? Consider these words by John Piper, "What Christ died for is not that we might help him, but that we might see and savor him as infinitely valuable. He died to wean us from poisonous pleasures and enthrall us with the pleasures of his beauty." In light of Christ's crucifixion are we savoring Jesus more than any earthly thing? As we contemplate His sacrifice for us are we moved to live each day treasuring His beauty and glory?

As Easter approaches let us seek ways to live out the achievements of the crucifixion and resurrection.
