Who Is Your One?

2018 is set to be a breakout year for Berea First Baptist—at least that's how we're praying. We've been seeking God and asking Him to use us right here in our community to connect people to Christ. Yet, for many of us, it's a daunting task to get out of our comfort zone and have a gospel conversation with someone. But did you know we're entering into a season when the people we encounter every day just might be more open to hearing the good news and possibly even attending church with us?

Easter is the most highly attended Sunday all year. What if, instead of just showing up that day in our spring pastels, we approached that day with some intentionality? What if we broke out of our routine and began to pray for someone? What if we went a step further than that and began to engage someone with the gospel? What if we did something as simple as inviting that person to Easter Sunday at Berea First Baptist?

This Sunday, we will be just over 40 days out from Easter. This is a season called Lent, during which you would normally give something up to prepare your heart for the remembrance of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. But what if this year, instead of giving something up, you took something on? Each day, we encounter people—family members, neighbors, co-workers, classmates, baristas at Starbucks—who have yet to encounter Jesus. We're asking Berea folks to identify at least one such person and commit to doing the following:

1. Pray for that person daily for the next forty days.
2. Engage with that person in a gospel conversation before Easter.
3. Invite that person to Berea First Baptist for Easter Sunday.

This Sunday, you will have the opportunity to write the first name of your person on a card. The card will be placed in our Welcome Center. This display will remain up through Easter Sunday for us to intercede on behalf of each person represented there, asking God to break through to each one as we break out to reach one.

Begin praying. Begin engaging. Begin inviting. Because we've all got one. The question is...WHO IS YOUR ONE?
