Intercessory Prayer Ministry Update

For many years now, we have been praying that God would make BFBC a house of prayer and we are seeing Him answer our prayers in so many ways. One way is the tremendous response on Prayer Ministry Focus Day of those who committed to serve in the Intercessory Prayer Ministry! We now have 22 new intercessors and 20 newly committed hours of prayer in the IPM prayer room, giving us a total of 53 hours of prayer per week. We are praising God with hearts of

thanksgiving and humility that He allows us to join Him in His Kingdom work on earth through our prayers!

The IPM is still in need of substitutes. A person serving in the IPM as a sub is willing to be called to fill in, if available when a weekly intercessor cannot attend their hour in the prayer room a particular week. Being a BFBC member, attending one orientation session, committing to confidentiality, and believing that God works through prayer are the only prerequisites for serving. The feeling I had the entire time I was there was one of being in God's presence and making an effort to please Him by becoming that connection between many hurting people and their God."
